Hello Marshall,

It does not appear the pump station called Optimization near Linton, ND is an obstruction to any Title 14 Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) Part 77 surfaces and is not in the near vicinity of any private airports. The height of the structure is not given in the letter we received, but the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires additional analysis to be done on structures over 499 above ground level (AGL). If the structure is above this height the FAA is required to be notified by completing the Notice of Proposed Construction or Alteration form (FAA 7460-1). The form can be found and submitted on the link below. Let me know if you have any questions.
