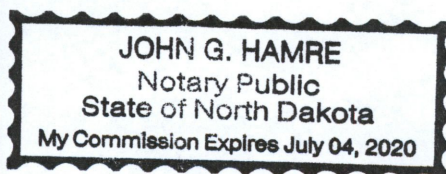


On June 20, 2019, Dakota Access, LLC filed a combined application with the Public Service Commission to amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 179 and Route Permit No. 191 for the addition of a pump station to its existing Dakota Access Pipeline. The pump station will be located in the South 1/2 Southeast 1/4 of Section 5, Township 132 North, Range 77 West, in Emmons County, North Dakota. The pump station will consist of five 6,000 horsepower electrically driven motors and pumps, which will allow for pipeline transportation of up to 1,100,000 total barrels of crude oil per day. 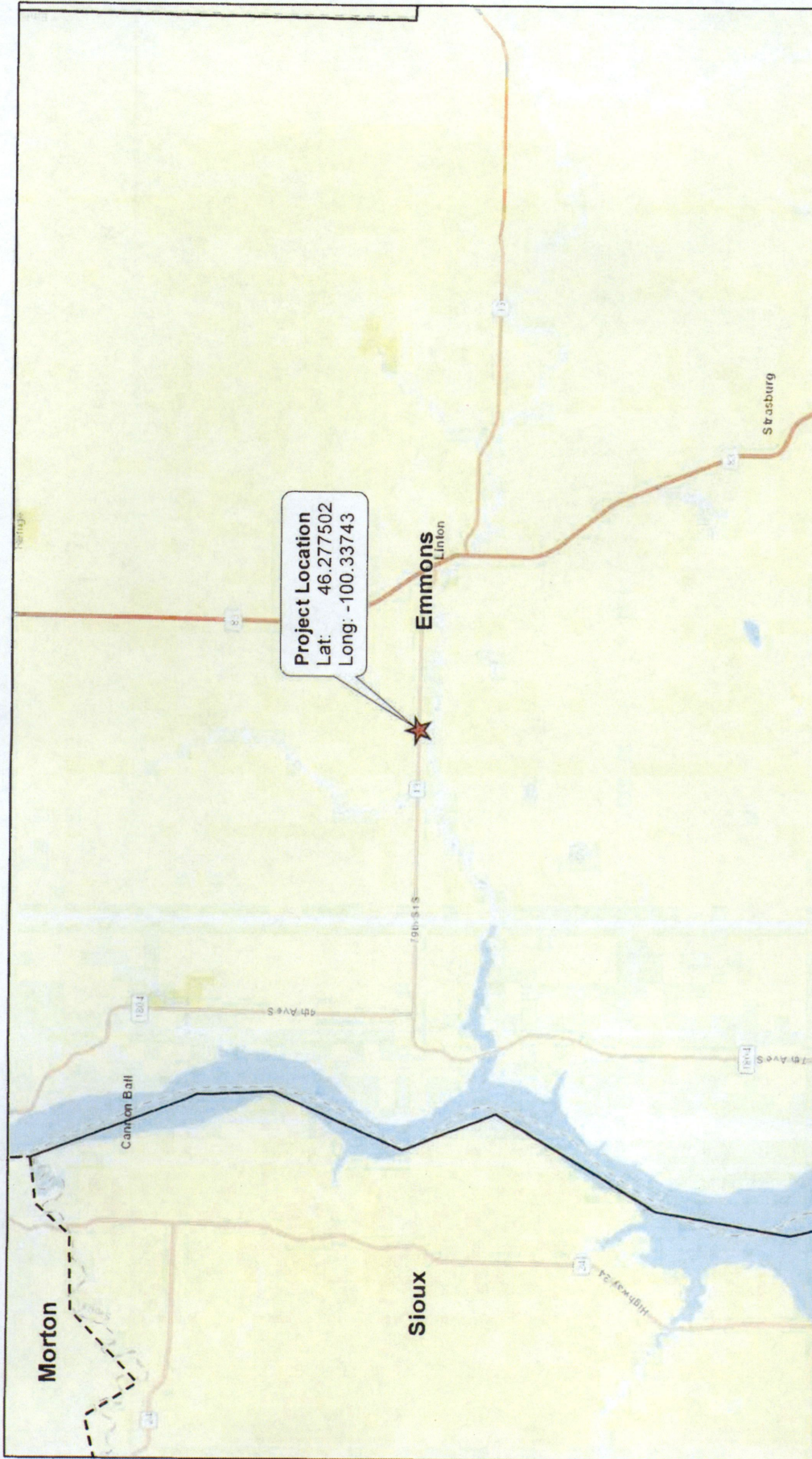
The Public Service Commission may not schedule a public hearing sooner than forty-five days from the date this notification is sent by mail or electronic mail. If a hearing is held, the Commission will issue a Notice of Hearing setting the hearing date.

Under North Dakota Century Code section 49-22-16(2)(d), political subdivisions shall provide a listing to the Public Service Commission of all local land use, zoning, or building rules, regulations or ordinances. The list of requirements must be filed at least ten days before the Commission hearing or the requirements are superseded and preempted.
