

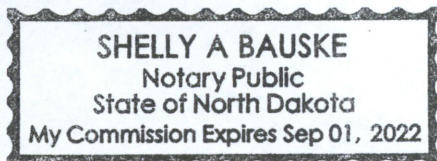

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**August 21, 2019**

On July 19, 2019, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed a change to its Transmission Cost Adjustment (TCA) rates to reflect updated electric transmission revenues and costs.

The effect of the rate change on the bill for a residential customer using 894 kWh per month is an increase of \$0.25 per month or \$3.00 per year.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
2. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by September 30, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
