We have previously worked in this same section and on the adjacent lot with one call tickets in 2017 and 2018 so I'm afraid our familiarity with the area may have led to a false sense of security of the area for myself and the operators.

This was a failure company wide however I am the one who did the COA and set up the borrow site and I assure you it was an oversight and not a blatant willful disregard of the laws and the one call system. We have taken steps to insure this does not happen again.

As soon as this was brought to my attention I filed a one call ticket. I would ask for leniency from the PSC as no damage occurred and there was no excavation that took place over any of the utilities or within their easements or ROWs.
