Dear Mr. Kahl:

The following information is provided on behalf of Emmons-Logan Wind, LLC and Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC (collectively, the “Applicants”) regarding the above-referenced matter and in response to an information request received by Commission staff. On October 3, 2019, the Applicants filed a Joint Application for Expedited Transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 208 and Route Permit No. 218 from Emmons-Logan Wind, LLC to Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC. The proposed transfers of the Certificate and Permit are intended to facilitate an internal corporate reorganization of the Transmission Line currently owned by Emmons-Logan Wind, LLC to the new entity, Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC. Both entities are indirect, wholly owned subsidiaries of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (“NextEra”). This reorganization and transfer of the Transmission Line is intended to implement a broader corporate initiative within NextEra to align generation tie lines with NextEra’s transmission business, in order to allow for more consistent internal treatment and for enhanced efficiencies across the organization.


Additionally, Emmons-Logan Wind, LLC is in the process of entering in to a financing transaction for the Emmons-Logan Wind Energy Center (PU-18-280), which transaction currently is scheduled to close on the Wind Energy Center’s commercial operation date (currently anticipated to be on or shortly after December 6, 2019). The Applicants are seeking to implement the reorganization of the transmission line described above prior to the closing of the

financing transaction for the Wind Energy Center, so that the transmission line is transferred to the new entity and not included in that transaction.
