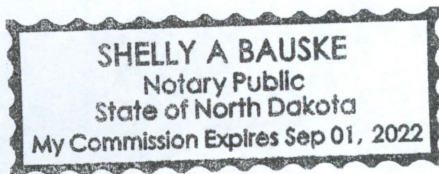

ORDER

December 3, 2019

Preliminary Statement

On February 6, 2019, in Case No. PU-18-281, the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 to Emmons-Logan Wind, LLC (Emmons-Logan) designating a corridor and a route for the construction and operation of a 6.85-mile, 230 kilovolt electric transmission line and associated facilities in Emmons County, North Dakota.

On October 3, 2019, in Case No. PU-19-333, Emmons-Logan and Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC (Emmons-Logan Interconnection) filed a joint application for expedited transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 from Emmons-Logan to Emmons-Logan Interconnection (Application).

On October 22, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing that provided until November 22, 2019 for receiving written comments and hearing requests. No comments or requests were received.

On November 21, 2019, Emmons-Logan and Emmons-Logan Interconnection filed supplemental information regarding the Application.

Discussion

The Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in Case No. PU-19-333 identified the issues to be considered are whether Emmons-Logan Interconnection agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC is a foreign limited liability company authorized to do business in North Dakota with a principal address of 700 Universe Blvd, Juno Beach, FL, 33408.

Emmons-Logan and Emmons-Logan Interconnection are both wholly-owned indirect subsidiaries of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, which is a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of NextEra Energy, Inc.

The Affidavit of Gregory Schneck, Vice President of Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC, states that Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC has the financial and technical qualifications to own the transmission facilities. Further, Emmons-Logan Interconnection agrees to assume the rights and obligations of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218, and agrees to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 and all applicable Commission orders pertaining to Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218.

The transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 is intended to implement a broader corporate initiative within NextEra's transmission business in order to allow for more consistent internal treatment and for enhanced efficiencies across the organization.

The transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 is compatible with the public interest.




Having considered this matter, the Commission finds Emmons-Logan Interconnection agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 and the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Order

The Commission orders:

1. The joint application of Emmons-Logan and Emmons-Logan Interconnection for transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 and Route Permit Number 218 is APPROVED.
2. First Reissued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 208 is issued to Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC.
3. First Reissued Route Permit Number 218 is issued to Emmons-Logan Wind Interconnection, LLC.


