

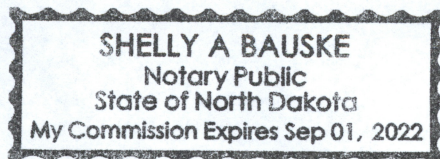

On **October 14, 2019**, Otter Tail Power Company, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N. D. C. C. to extend service to Justin & Allen Zerr (Zerr Family Farm) at a location in Wells County, North Dakota.
