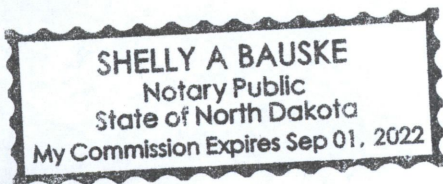


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 7, 2019

On April 1, 2019, in Case No. PU-19-107, the Commission adopted an Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility for Energy Conversion Facility, Third Amended Certificate Number 30, to Allete Clean Energy, Inc. (Allete) designating the location for the construction and operation of a wind energy conversion facility consisting of up to 50 wind turbine generators with up to 106 megawatts (MW) of generating capacity in Mercer and Morton Counties, North Dakota.

On October 23, 2019, Allete and Glen Ullin Energy Center, LLC (GUEC) filed a joint application for transfer of Third Amended Certificate Number 30 from Allete to GUEC, Case No. PU-19-343.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-19-343 are whether GUEC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Third Amended Certificate Number 30 and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by December 6, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
