

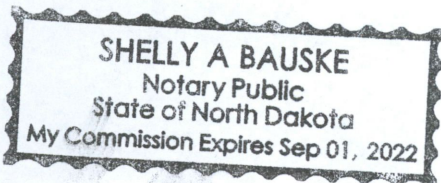

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NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 21, 2019

On May 30, 2008, in Case No. PU-08-73 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 104 and Route Permit No. 114 to Ashtabula Wind, LLC for the construction and operation of the approximately 9.5-mile, 230 kV transmission line and associated facilities in Barnes County, North Dakota.

On October 30, 2019, in Case No. PU-19-345, Ashtabula Wind, LLC and Ashtabula Wind I, LLC filed a joint application for transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 104 and Route Permit No. 114 from Ashtabula Wind, LLC to Ashtabula Wind I, LLC.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-19-345 are whether Ashtabula Wind I, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 104 and Route Permit No. 114, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.


Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by December 19, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
