



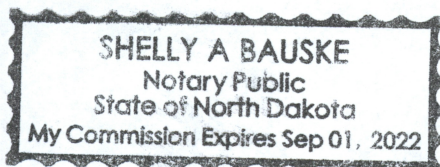

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NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING

January 22, 2020

A public hearing on the application in Case No. PU-19-368 is scheduled for **March 6, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time at the City of Williston Public Works and Engineering Department, 1121 5th Street East, Williston, ND 58801.**

ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. filed a combined application for a corridor certificate and route permit for the location of a natural gas liquids pipeline, approximately 75-miles long located in North Dakota in Williams County. The pipeline location is shown on the attached map.


The issues in the combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit are:

1. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility at the proposed location produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility at the proposed location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?





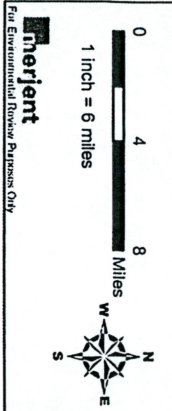
