**Reference: OneOK Bakken Pipeline LLC, Tioga Lateral PU-19-368**

Wenck Associates Inc. (now part of Stantec Consulting Services Inc.), herein referred to as Wenck, represents the North Dakota Public Service Commission as a third-party inspector on Case Number PU-19-368, the ONEOK Tioga Lateral Pipeline Project. As the Project Manager for Contract Number PU-826-20, corresponding to the aforementioned project, I am officially requesting the as-built alignment GIS shapefiles. Wenck is of the opinion, access to the as-built GIS file is needed for an accurate and efficient review during compliance inspections. This as-built centerline location has already been provided graphically via the case file docket (filed November 2020). Wenck is under the impression the GIS files are no more sensitive than these previously filed print maps. Nevertheless, to fulfil the requirements of N.D. Admin. Code 69-02-09-07- Viewing Protected Information, the following is being provided:

- a. The name and address of the person who will view the information;

  - c. *Kevin Mueller, Wenck Associates, 7500 Olson Memorial Highway, Suite 300, Golden Valley, MN 55359; and,*
  - d. *Other Wenck-Stantec project-team staff as warranted during project inspections and reporting.*
- b. Identification, as specifically as possible, of the information requested;
  - a. *The electronic copy (GIS .shp file) of the as-built location of the transmission facility, as required to be submitted in item #33 of the Certificate Relating to Order Provisions.*
- c. A showing of good cause why the information is needed;
  - a. *For accuracy and efficiency in fulfilling our duty as the Contractor for Construction Inspections of this project.*
- d. Identification of the purpose of the review;
  - a. *To assess the "determination whether the transmission facility has been constructed in compliance with the siting laws, siting rules, and applicable commission orders" as outlined in Wenck's Contract.*
- e. Identification of the intended use of the information;
  - a. *Review and comparisons of the actual location of the facility during field inspections and desktop review.*
- f. An estimate of the time needed for review;
  - a. *For the remaining duration of Wenck's Contract for the associated project.*
