
On behalf of Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation (“Whiting”) and in response to your request dated March 21, 2022, in the above-referenced matter, we are providing a status update on future construction plans for the Robinson Lake Oil Conditioning Facility Expansion Project (“Project”). To date, no construction work has occurred regarding the Project. Whiting’s current plan is to begin construction in June 2022 with an estimated completion in September 2022. Construction will include civil work for poured concrete foundations, mechanical labor, electrical labor and automation/controls efforts.

The scope of work for the Project will include installing and upgrading components of the facility to reach a nameplate capacity of 65,000 bopd. The major equipment changes will include the following:

- New 35,000 bopd heater (H-1300) that will operate in parallel with the existing heaters (H-1100 and H-1200);
- New inlet heat exchanger (E-1000) to replace existing heat exchanger;
- New pumps (P-2010, P-2020 and P-2030); and
- New VRU (V-3100) that will operate in parallel with the existing VRU (V-3000).
