If the State of North Dakota has the resources to conduct this meeting with 100 percent participation, there should be a significant lead time to ensure that everyone wishing to participate can do so. This would include identifying and notification of all potential participants, as well as ensuring the proper equipment to allow participation. We do not accept that these steps are possible between now and April 17<sup>th</sup>.

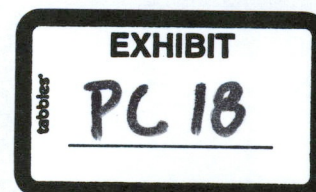

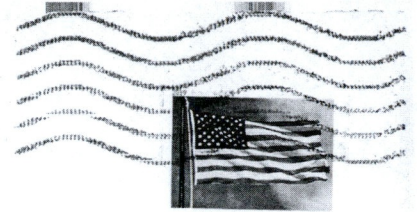
