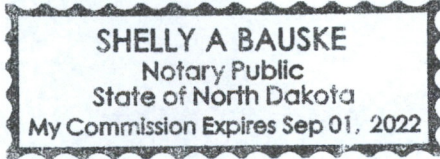

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

April 15, 2020

On March 9, 2020, Northern States Power Company dba Excel Energy (NSP) filed changes to its outdoor lighting tariffs. NSP proposes tariff language updates and a new rate for a new municipal and customer owned LED lighting service that it believes to be more economical than existing options.

The issues to consider in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by May 29, 2019.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
