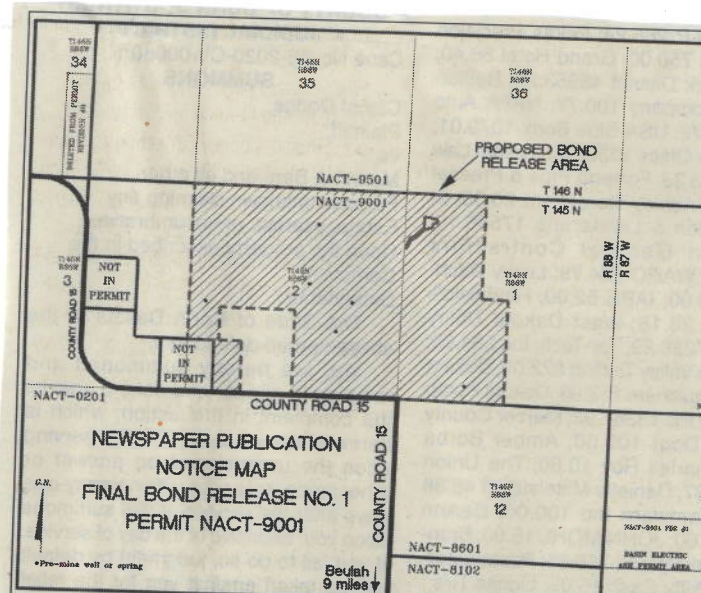

**NOTICE OF FILING FOR FINAL RELEASE OF RECLAMATION BOND**

The Coteau Properties Company, as applicant, has filed an application for final bond release on approximately 812 acres of land located in Section 1, T145N, R88W and Section 2, T145N, R88W as indicated on the map. This land is included in Surface Coal Mining Permit NACT-9001, approved by the North Dakota Public Service Commission on April 16, 1991. This permit area is bonded in consolidation with adjacent mining permits for an amount totaling \$146 million. Upon approval of this bond release application, The Coteau Properties Company will be released from reclamation liability for all stages (backfilling and grading, soil spreading, vegetation establishment, and revegetation success), but the bond amount will not be reduced due to continued mining and reclamation operations within this permit.

Following permit approval, initial mining disturbance commenced with sediment pond construction and soil stripping in 1991. Within the tract, six pre-mining wells and springs existed. Coal removal began in 1992 and continued through 1998. Reclamation began after coal removal and continued until 2014 when reclamation of the approximately 683 acres that were disturbed

from mining or considered to associated disturbance was completed. The bond release tract was given a variance from the ten-year revegetation responsibility period on 132.9 acres on September 9, 2019. The county established to meet the standards set forth by Mercer County. The entire release tract is owned by The Coteau Properties Company, and the area has been successfully reclaimed to grassland, developed water resources, a wetland, Mercer County Road 15, and a section line right-of-way.

Written comments, objections, requests for an informal conference or public hearing on this bond release may be submitted by any person having a valid legal interest which is or may be adversely affected by this action to the North Dakota Public Service Commission, 600 East Boulevard A, Department 408, Bismarck, ND 58104, within 30 days after the publication of this notice. Any request for an informal conference or hearing should be in writing to the Commission and must state specifically the issues or objections that an affected party regarding this bond release.
