Subject: Close out of Contract Number AM-828-20 for the 2020 Williams County Road 9 Phase 8 Material Testing AML Project, Case No. AM-20-183

On May 27, 2020, the Commission entered Contract No. AM-828-20 with Material Testing Services, LLC. for the grout testing and other services for the 2020 Williams County Road 9 Phase 8 Material Testing AML Project. This project involved rotary drilling to locate underground mine voids and the injection of pressurized grout into mine voids beneath roads and near structures in Williams County. Ross Edison along with Derek Faul and James Thornberg supervised this project.

The original contract with Material Testing Services, LLC. for related services was in the amount of \$27,725.00. The work estimates and actual totals for this contract are shown in the table below.

The final cost of Contract AM-828-20 was \$30,373.55, which is 109.6% of the original contract amount. One change order was issued to increase the quantities for Field Representative hours as well as Laboratory Testing series.

All work has been completed; the final invoice has been paid; and we have received the Certification of Payment. We recommend Contract AM-828-20 be closed.
