Re: Waiver of Months to Exhaust Threshold Requirement – Fargo Rate Center

Dear Mr. Kahl,

Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. (CCES) requests the North Dakota Public Service Commission to direct the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) to provide CCES with additional NXXs in its Fargo, North Dakota Rate Center.

Consolidated has requested a block of One (1) consecutive 1000 number block (701-NXX 5000 through 5999) for use with a customer service request from The City of West Fargo to accommodate the City's request for consecutive numbers since there is no current gap of 1000 DIDs in the current/existing DID number block.

On January 20, 2020, CCES submitted a request to NANPA for the requested NXX in accordance with current guidelines, including the Months to Exhaust Certification (see attached Appendix 2, Thousands-Block Months to Exhaust Certification Worksheet - TN Level). This request is made because CCES does not have the blocks of sequential numbers available within the Fargo Rate Center in West Fargo, ND and is unable to use numbers from another switch to satisfy the customer's request. On January 20, 2020, the NANPA's Pooling Administrator denied the request on the grounds that CCES had not met the MTE threshold necessary in order to obtain growth number resources (see attached Pooling Administrator's Response/Confirmation - Part 3A).

The FCC's March 31, 2000 Order in its Number Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier may challenge a NANPA decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission, and that the state commission may affirm or overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources. Furthermore, in the FCC's December 28, 2001 Order in its Number Resource Optimization docket, the FCC states that a carrier should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a customer request. In the December 28, 2001 Order, the FCC

additionally states that a carrier may utilize a "safety valve" in which the state commissions may expeditiously review and act upon a carrier request, in most instances, within 10 business days

CCES formally requests that the Commission review and overturn NANPA's decision so that we may meet the demands of our customer, The City of West Fargo, and provide the services requested so that The City of West Fargo may meet the needs of its operations.
