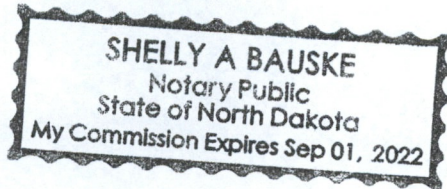

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On **May 20, 2020**, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., an electric public utility, filed an application under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-03 to extend service to Ross Eriksmoen at a location in Divide County, ND.
