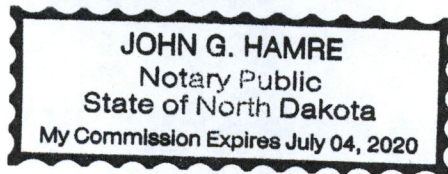

NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING

July 2, 2020

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-20-247 will be held remotely due to the state emergency to begin at 8:00 AM CT on August 6, 2020.

**Public input** received by the Commission will be placed into the record for consideration. The Commission will receive testimony through the following methods:

- **Telephonic** – The public may provide input over the phone by calling 701-328-4081 to be placed on a list. On August 6, 2020, the Commission will call you back to receive your input at the end of the hearing in an order determined by the Administrative Law Judge.

On June 3, 2020, OE2 North LLC (OE2) filed a combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permits concerning the location of approximately 1.28 miles of 8-inch natural gas liquids pipeline and approximately 4.67 miles of 20-inch residue gas pipeline in Williams County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

OE2 has also filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22.1-05, 49-22.1-06, 49-22.1-07, and 49-22.1-10, and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02 and chapter 69-06-06, requiring separate notices and separate hearings on such applications.

OE2 has also requested a waiver of the proposed corridor width required under North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-05-01(2)(f).

The issues in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:


1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues in the application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permits are:

1. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facilities at the proposed locations produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facilities at the proposed locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

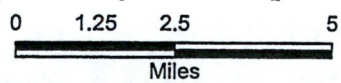
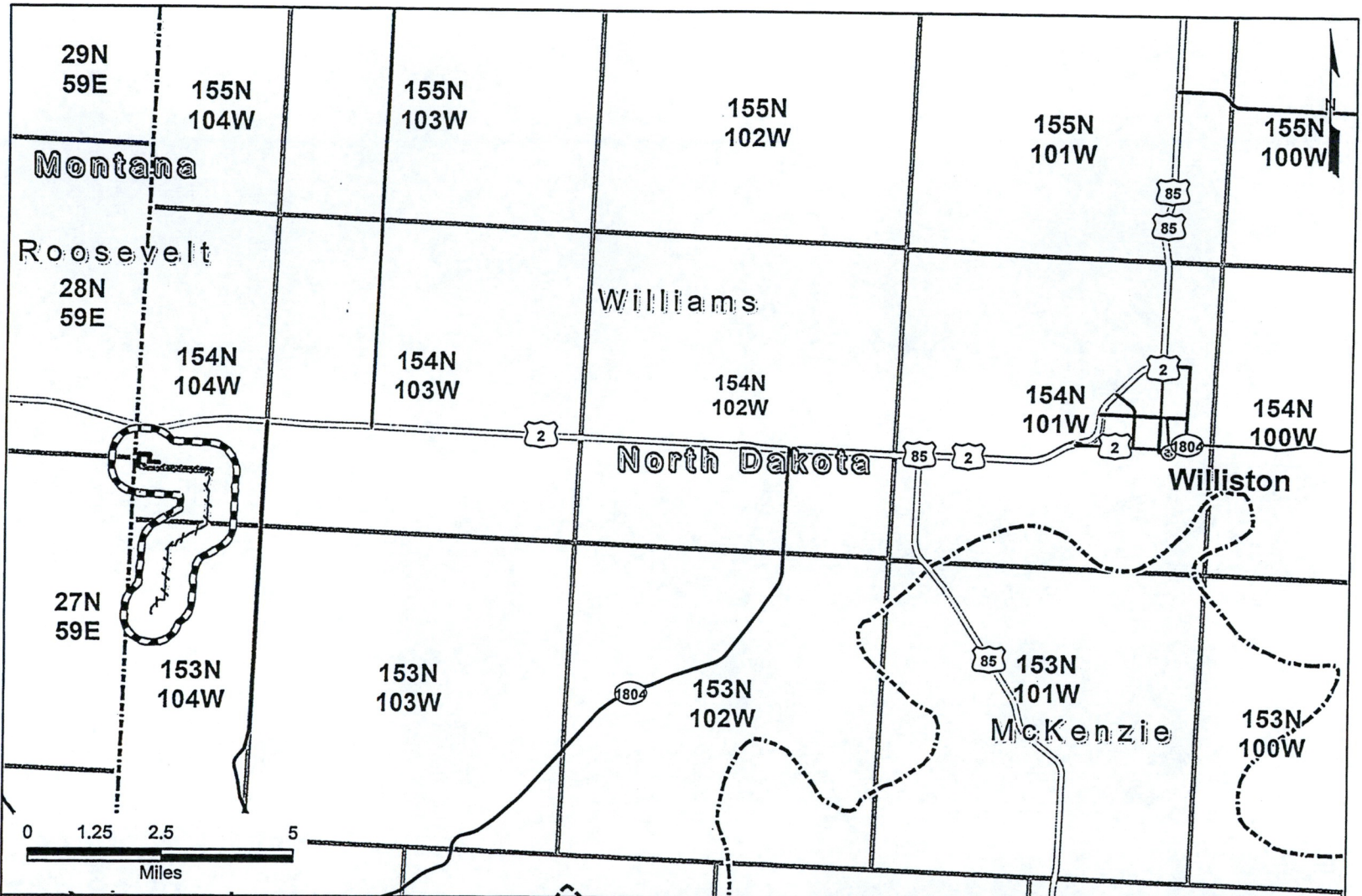

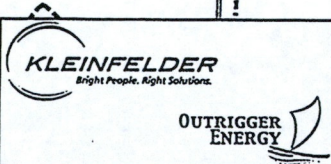
