2	Request for percentage pastureland and percentage crop land crossed by the pipeline route.	A Land Use Map, which is included as Figure A-3 in Appendix A to the Application (page OE2 070, Exhibit 1) depicts the pastureland and crop land crossed by the pipeline route. For the NGL Line, 60.5% of the pipeline route crosses crop land and 39.5% of the pipeline route crosses pastureland (herbaceous). For the Residue Line, 45.2% of the pipeline route crosses crop land, 51% of the pipeline route crosses pastureland (herbaceous), 2% of the pipeline route crosses Developed, Open space, and 1.8% of the pipeline route crosses Shrub/Scrub. 3	Question regarding the 10-day limitation on a response from the Williams County Weed Control Board in the Weed Management Plan for the Project which is attached as Appendix J to the Application (page OE2 255, Exhibit 1).	OE2 removed the 10-day limitation from the Weed Management Plan prior to submitting it to the Weed Board. In addition, OE2 has engaged the County Weed Director, county commissioners, NRCS, landowners, and tenant farmers/ranchers on the route for input on reclamation and weed control.	No
