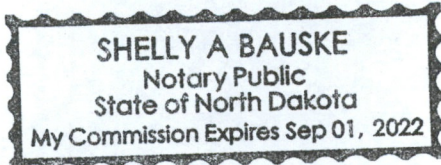


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NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

July 8, 2020

On June 5, 2020, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for approval of modifications to its Transmission Facility Cost Recovery Tariff. The Tariff modification is intended to clarify the methodology used to annually true-up the recovery of qualifying costs in the Transmission Facility Cost Recovery Rider.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed changes reasonable?
2. Is there other relevant information the Commission should consider?

Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by August 22, 2020.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
