

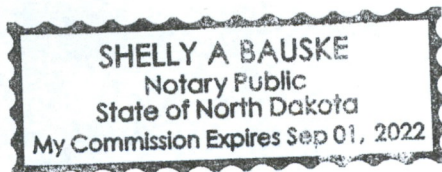

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

July 23, 2020

On August 10, 2005, in Case No. PU-05-205, the Commission issued Corridor Certificate No. 88 and Route Permit No. 98 to FPL Energy Burleigh County Wind, LLC for construction of approximately 4 miles of 230 kV electric transmission line in Burleigh County, ND.


On July 1, 2020, FPL Energy Burleigh County Wind, LLC and Wilton Wind Energy 1, LLC filed a joint application for transfer of Corridor Certificate No. 88 and Route Permit No. 98 from FPL Energy Burleigh County Wind, LLC to Wilton Wind Energy I, LLC.

The issues to be considered in this matter are whether Wilton Wind Energy 1, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Corridor Certificate Number 88 and Route Permit Number 98 and whether the requested transfers are compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by August 31, 2020.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.


