

The Langdon Wind Energy Center (“Langdon Wind”) is located approximately 170 miles northwest of Fargo in Cavalier County, ND. Langdon Wind consists of thirteen (13) GE 1.5 SLE and ninety-three (93) GE 1.62 wind turbines and has been in production since December 2007. Langdon Wind contributes approximately 159 MW of renewable energy to the power grid. The project is not expected to retire in the next ten years—three Power Purchase Agreements (PPA) (two with Minnkota Power Cooperative and one with Otter Tail Power Company) these are in place through the end of November 2038 and October 2038, and December 2032, respectively.

1. Langdon Wind has a nameplate capacity of 159 MW and sells the output to Minnkota Power Cooperative and Otter Tail Power Company under three long-term PPAs to meet the needs of their customers and member cooperatives.

1. Langdon Wind conducted multiple environmental studies prior to construction of the facilities and met all environmental requirements of the NEPA Environmental Assessment (EA) process. Langdon Wind is also committed to environmental compliance during project operation.
 - a. Comprehensive Wildlife Response and Reporting Manuals are in place to record any avian fatalities and/or injuries that are found within the wind plant boundaries.
 - b. Adaptive Management Plans were developed for both construction activities and post-construction operations. Appropriate responses for various types of avian sightings are detailed within.

- c. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plans specify processes for dealing with all chemical, hazardous, and oil spills that may occur on the property.


