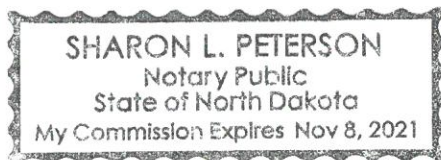

On August 23, 2006, in Case No. PU-06-312, the Commission issued Corridor Certificate No. 92 and Route Permit No. 102 to FPL Energy Oliver County Wind, LLC for construction of approximately 542 feet of 230 kV electric transmission line in Oliver County, ND.

On October 8, 2008, as corrected on September 21, 2016, in Case No. PU-08-241, the Commission adopted an Order approving the transfer of the certificate and permit from FPL Energy Oliver County Wind, LLC to FPL Energy Oliver Wind 1, LLC.

On August 14, 2020, FPL Energy Oliver Wind 1, LLC and Oliver Wind 1, LLC filed a joint application for transfer of Corridor Certificate No. 92 and Route Permit No. 102 from FPL Energy Oliver Wind 1, LLC to Oliver wind 1, LLC.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether Oliver Wind 1, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Corridor Certificate Number 92 and Route Permit Number 102, and

2. Whether the requested transfers are compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by September 30, 2020. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

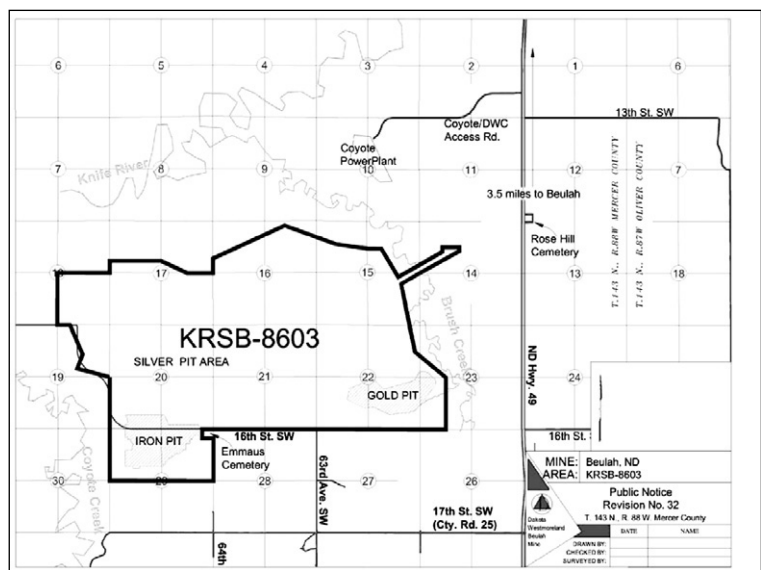

### 2020 FALL WILD TURKEY HUNTING PROCLAMATION SUMMARY

The North Dakota Game & Fish Department announces the following summary of regulations and changes for the 2020 Fall Wild Turkey hunting season.

- Licenses will be issued by a weighted lottery procedure. Applications may be submitted online or by phone. Only residents may apply. The deadline for submitting online or phone applications is September 2, 2020.
- The season will run from October 10, 2020 through January 3, 2021.
- The bag limit will be one wild turkey of any sex or age per license.
- Turkeys may be legally taken with shotguns, muzzleloading long guns, certain handguns, and bow and arrow.

#### SUMMARY OF CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR

- Total licenses available increased to 3,785 (up from 3,660). Additional licenses, up to a maximum of 1,300, may be issued for specific hunting units.
- Unit 47 will be opened back up to fall turkey hunting in 2020.
- Unit 21 will remain closed to fall turkey hunting in 2020.
