

REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

RE: OPERATION AND OWNERSHIP OF THIRD-PARTY EV CHARGING

On August 5, 2020, the Commission held a work session with its regulated community regarding jurisdictional issues surrounding the development of EV charging stations in North Dakota. Otter Tail Power, Northern States Power, and Montana-Dakota Utilities were in attendance. The discussion encompassed the Commission's jurisdiction, whether statutory changes were necessary, and scenarios of impact on North Dakota customers.

On September 9, 2020, the commissioners directed Staff to investigate, solicit comments from interested stakeholders, and provide a recommendation to the Commission regarding areas that may need clarification regarding the Commission's jurisdiction related to ownership and operation of EV charging stations.
