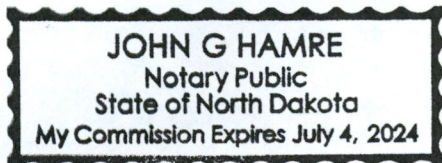

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

October 21, 2020

On July 14, 2010, in Case No. PU-09-668, the Commission issued Site Certificate Number 16 for the construction and operation of the Baldwin Wind Energy Center in Burleigh County, ND.

On September 29, 2020 Baldwin Wind, LLC and Baldwin Wind Energy, LLC filed a joint application for transfer of Site Certificate number 16 to Baldwin Wind Energy, LLC

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether Baldwin Wind Energy, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Site Certificate Number 16 and
2. Whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by November 25, 2020.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
