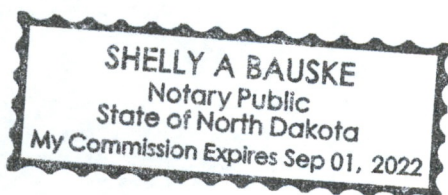

**NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION**

**December 7, 2020**

On October 21, 2020, Bridger Pipeline, LLC filed a combined application with the Public Service Commission for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit for the conversion of an approximately 27 mile-long existing 8-inch crude oil gathering pipeline to a transmission line, along with the construction of an approximately 2.4 mile-long 8-inch crude oil transmission line, all located within McKenzie County, North Dakota. A map showing the pipeline location is attached. The application may be reviewed online at the following web link:

The Public Service Commission may not schedule a public hearing sooner than forty-five days from the date this notification is sent by mail or electronic mail. The Commission will issue a Notice of Hearing setting the hearing date.

Under North Dakota Century Code section 49-22.1-13(2)(d), political subdivisions shall provide a listing to the Public Service Commission of all local land use, zoning, or building rules, regulations or ordinances. The list of requirements must be filed at least ten days before the Commission hearing or the requirements are superseded and preempted.
