Thank you for your September 28, 2021 filing notifying the Commission of Bridger Pipeline, LLC's (Bridger) intent to adjust the route of the new pipeline outside the designated corridor at a location in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

Prior to construction of the 1.3-mile pipeline, Bridger must file the following with the Commission, and may not begin construction until Staff sends its letter acknowledging the filing is complete:

- 1) Class III Concurrence Letter from the ND State Historic Preservation Office
- 2) Tree and Shrub Inventory mentioned on page 12 of the September 28, 2021 filing.
- 3) Easement agreements or supporting documentation with each owner of real property on which the adjustment is to be located and any applicable governmental entity with an interest in the same adjustment area do not oppose the adjustment.
- 4) Discussion of how Bridger determined there were no geologically unstable areas in the proposed rerouted corridor.
- 5) The date that field surveys were conducted within the proposed rerouted corridor for state-listed protected species and critical habitat, and whether any such species or critical habitat were located as a result.

- 6) A complete discussion of how Bridger determined whether there were no Type A or Type B habitat for the Dakota skipper within the proposed rerouted corridor.
- 7) The following GIS shapefiles:
 - a. Block Valve
 - b. Wetlands
 - c. Noxious Weeds
 - d. Potential Area of Instability
 - e. Rerouted Pipeline Corridor
 - f. Named Streams
 - g. Highway
 - h. Roads
 - i. 1-mile Study Area
 - j. Woody Vegetation
