

Dear PSC,

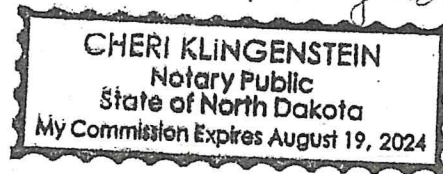

Public use business, traveling north to cross river by Washburn (center to Minot) School activities public meeting, ambulance, fire trucks.

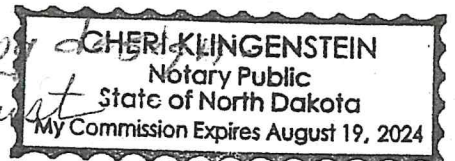
