A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 38-14.1-19 and subsection 3 of section 38-14.1-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to extending time for scheduling an informal conference and application for a permit renewal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 38-14.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

38-14.1-19. Informal conference procedures.

1. If written objections or comments are filed and an informal conference is requested as provided in section 38-14.1-17, 38-14.1-18, or 38-14.1-28, the commission shall schedule such informal conference within ~~thirty~~forty-five days of the receipt of such request but in no event prior to the expiration of the ~~thirty-day~~ forty-five day period allowed for submission of comments, objections, and requests in subsection 2 of section 38-14.1-17 or subsections 3, 4, and 5 of section 38-14.1-18.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of Section 38-14.1-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

38-14.1-22. Permit renewal.

3. Any permit renewal must be for a term not to exceed the period of the original permit established by this chapter. Application for permit renewal

must be made at least one hundred ~~twenty~~ eighty days prior to the
expiration of the valid permit.
