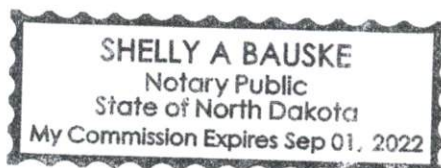


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

May 27, 2021

On May 21, 2021, Great Plains Natural Gas Co. filed an application for a variance to its cost of gas true-up pursuant to the terms of North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-39, Automatic Adjustment Clauses. The variance would extend the time for recovery of an under-collected balance of the cost of gas adjustment from 12 months to 23 months from July 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether it is appropriate to grant a waiver of the Commission's rules under North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-39, Automatic Adjustment Clauses, for the stated purpose.
2. Whether the proposed rate change is just and reasonable.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by June 18, 2021.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
