Late-Filed Exhibit 12 - Belle Fourche 10-Year Spill History

On May 5, 2022, a public hearing was held on Bridger Pipeline LLC's ("Bridger") South Bend Pipeline application. During this proceeding, the Commission requested Bridger file a ten-year spill history for its affiliate Belle Fourche Pipeline Company ("Belle Fourche"). This information was designated by the presiding Administrative Law Judge as Late-Filed Exhibit No. 12. Pursuant to this designation, Bridger submits Belle Fourche's ten-year spill history. Consistent with the scope of information provided by Bridger in its spill-history (Docket No. 15), Late-Filed Exhibit No. 12 contains information regarding Belle Fourche related releases greater than five barrels of liquids in the state of North Dakota.

Belle Fourche's ten-year spill history was previously submitted to the Commission on March 19, 2019 by Belle Fourche in Case No. PU-18-404, pertaining to the siting of Belle Fourche's 8-inch Wilson to Bowline Pipeline Conversion Project located in McKenzie County. *See* Case No. PU-18-404, Docket No. 22.¹

¹ Bridger notes that Belle Fourche's spill history filed in PU-18-404 included releases over one barrel and thus includes two additional releases not reflected on the enclosed chart. Specifically, a 5/21/2012 two-barrel release on the Red Wind Gathering Line and a 6/13/2014 two-barrel release on the Bull Moose Line.
