

The following information is submitted on behalf of Bridger Pipeline LLC (“Bridger”). At the May 5, 2022 hearing in the above-referenced matter, discussion arose pertaining to Bridger and its affiliate, Belle Fourche Pipeline Company, engaging a third-party entity to perform an audit regarding control room operations and associated processes and procedures. At the hearing, the Commission inquired if Bridger would voluntarily engage a consultant to conduct such an audit. Bridger hereby provides notice to the Commission that Bridger will voluntarily engage a consultant to perform such an audit, and that it is in the process of evaluating potential consultants to perform such scope of work.
