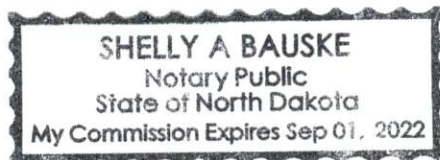

NOTICE OF FILING AND HEARING

March 3, 2021

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-21-49 is scheduled to begin **May 6, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. CDT, at Mountrail County South Complex, 8103 61st Street NW, Stanley, ND 58784.**

On January 27, 2021, Basin Electric Power Cooperative filed a combined application for a corridor certificate and a route permit to construct approximately 26.5 miles of 230 kV electric transmission line and associated facilities extending from the existing Naset Substation to a new proposed Northshore Substation in Mountrail County, North Dakota, also as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
