In accordance with item 38 of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions in the above-referenced case, enclosed please find a notarized certification indicating Basin Electric Power Cooperative's (**Basin Electric's**) route adjustment inside the designated corridor will not affect any known exclusion or avoidance areas as defined in North Dakota Administrative Code 69-06-08-02 (1) and (2). The route adjustment is at the request of the landowner; the owner of the parcel encompassing the reroute does not oppose the route adjustment and has signed an easement with Basin Electric.

As depicted on the attached figure, Basin Electric intends to make a minor adjustment to the location of structure 150, moving it approximately 16 feet to the south of the originally proposed structure location. Studies by biological and cultural resource consultants completed in support of Basin Electric's corridor and route application confirm there are no exclusion or avoidance areas affected.

Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 222 and Route Permit Number 232 were issued by the North Dakota Public Service Commission for the transmission line on June 23, 2021. Basin Electric will comply with all applicable conditions and protections in siting laws and rules and previously issued commission orders.


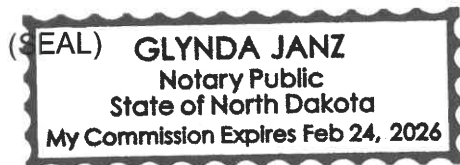
