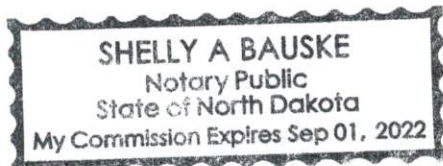



NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

February 17, 2021

On February 3, 2021, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed changes to section 11.07 of its outdoor street and area lighting tariffs. OTP requests approval of new decorative outdoor lighting options and tariff language clarification changes. OTP also proposes new lighting rates for primary metered customers.

The issues to consider in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by March 22, 2021.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
