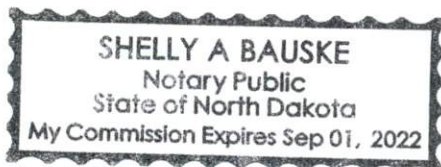

**ORDER**

**Preliminary Statement**

On February 3, 2021, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed changes to section 11.07 of its outdoor street and area lighting tariffs. OTP requests approval of new decorative outdoor lighting options and tariff language clarification changes. OTP also proposes new lighting rates for primary metered customers.

On February 17, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing that provided until March 22, 2021 for receiving written comments and hearing requests. No response was received. The notice identified that the issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates and tariff revision just and reasonable?


**Discussion**

Having considered this matter, the Commission finds Otter Tail's proposed rates and tariff revisions for its proposed LED lighting service are just, reasonable, in compliance with the tariff and should be approved. Therefore, the Commission issues its:

**Order**

The Commission Orders Otter Tail's 2021 LED Street and Area Lighting Dusk til Dawn Service is APPROVED.
