1. The Company will provide quarterly construction progress reports indicating the development status of each Wind Repowering Project, until the last Project is in service.

Rock Aetna	22	Murray County, MN	Xcel Energy acquired Rock Aetna in November 2022, and the project achieved COD December 9, 2022.
Nobles	201	Nobles County, MN	This project achieved COD November 30, 2022, one month earlier than budgeted.
