In accordance with Term C.2 of the Settlement Agreement stated above, on at least an annual basis, Xcel Energy shall file a letter with the Commission in these Cases advising whether the trade secret information must remain secret or if it may be made public. The Company can confirm that the trade secret information must remain trade secret at this time.

Consistent with Term C.1 (quoted above) the Company believes it has fully complied with this requirement and shall cease quarterly reporting going forward. However, we will continue with our annual reporting on trade secret information to remain in compliance with Term C.2.
