3.5 VACATION SERVICE

3.5.1 General

- A. Upon written or verbal request of a customer to any class of Basic Exchange Telephone Service, the service may be placed on Vacation Service for a minimum period of one month, up to a maximum period of six months. No outward or inward service is given during the period of suspension.
1. Vacation Service may begin and terminate on any date of the month, provided notice is given sufficiently in advance for arrangements to be made. Customer must be current on all charges before Vacation Service can be applied.
 2. A customer will receive a 100 percent reduction of Basic Exchange Telephone Service Charges during the period of Vacation Service.
 3. A temporary out of service message will be received if someone calls a customer's Basic Exchange Telephone Service line during Vacation Service.
 4. Vacation Service is available to Business and Residential customers.
