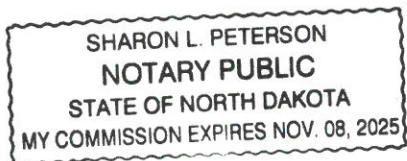

Many teams facing QB question marks

INDIANAPOLIS — The buzz at the NFL scouting combine Tuesday wasn't so much about this year's unheralded crop of quarterback prospects. It was on veterans who may or may not be on the move this month.

Packers GM Brian Gutekunst said he still doesn't know if two-time reigning MVP Aaron Rodgers wants to return, retire or relocate. He expects an answer soon.

Cardinals GM Steve Keim said he'll exercise the fifth-year option on disgruntled QB Kyler Murray's contract.

Texans GM Nick Caserio demurred when asked about embattled QB Deshaun Watson, who was held out last season after being accused of sexual misconduct.

"We're day to day in terms of handling that," Caserio said. "We're always going to do the right thing by the Houston Texans organization."

Colts GM Chris Ballard indicated he wasn't yet sold on former No. 2 overall draft pick Carson Wentz as the long-term answer in Indianapolis, and neither GM Terry Fontenot nor coach Arthur Smith would commit to Matt Ryan remaining the Falcons' starting quarterback next season.

Browns GM Andrew Berry told local reporters he fully expects Baker Mayfield to be the starter in Cleveland in 2022, and suspects offseason surgery on Mayfield's non-throwing shoulder will facilitate a successful comeback.

"The reality is that we have seen him play at a high level before. Being realistic, the injury does have some impact on his performance," Berry said. "We are focused on him getting healthy. We know how he works. We think he is talented. We have seen him play at a playoff-caliber level before, and I do not think there is any reason to think he can't rebound to that level next year."

On Tuesday, Cowboys coach Mike McCarthy revealed that quarterback Dak Prescott had offseason surgery on his non-throwing shoulder, but said it didn't appear to negatively affect him last season.

No team in the NFL has had as much trouble under center over the last few seasons as the Denver Broncos, who have churned through 10 starting quarterbacks since Peyton Manning's retirement. The latest, Teddy Bridgewater, who went 7-7 last year, but was the best of the bunch.

Finding a worthy successor to Manning — a year after his Hall of Fame induction — is job No. 1 for Denver GM George Paton. "It's always a priority," Paton said. "It's the most important position in sports, so we're always looking."

Along with just about everyone else. The Broncos have been mentioned as a potential landing spot for Rodgers should he ask out of Green Bay.

"We just want the best guy. We don't care if it's

free agency; we don't care if it's the draft; we don't care if it's a trade," said Paton. "We're going to exhaust all options to try to get the best guy for the Broncos."

Saying "there's no new updates" on Rodgers' situation, Gutekunst seemed to speculate the four-time MVP wasn't all-in on playing an 18th NFL season yet.

"With Aaron, I think he's got a very tough process that he goes through to get himself ready to play every season. It's a big commitment, and he's done that for a long time and it certainly shows in the results," Gutekunst said. "I think he feels he needs to do that to play at the level he plays that. And so I know that weighs on him, but I think he's going through that now."

Gutekunst said he expects to know Rodgers' decision before the league's new year kicks off March 16 with the start of free agency.

Ballard said he will continue meeting with Colts coach Frank Reich and team owner Jim Irsay, and hopes to make a decision at quarterback in the next 10 days. "Ultimately, you've got to have a guy you believe in," Ballard said. "I'm not saying we don't, but in the long term is that the best answer for us? We're not there yet, I'm not there yet."

There's also chatter about Seattle's Russell Wilson wanting a fresh start, and both the Buccaneers (Tom Brady) and Steelers (Ben Roethlisberger) need to replace elite quarterbacks this offseason.

"I would say we're open to any" quarterbacks, Steelers GM Kevin Colbert said. "We have two veterans on our roster in Mason Rudolph and Dwayne Haskins. Both have started NFL games and both have won NFL games. So we'll see how things evolve."

Murray recently deleted all references to the Cardinals on his social media accounts, but he isn't fading from their view at all.

"Kyler Murray, to me, is someone really different from anyone else I've ever evaluated," Keim said. "He can do it all and he's very competitive and he wants to be great. Those are all strengths."

"When I look back three years ago, see the progress he's made on and off the field, it's been tremendous. And he's a big part of our turnaround."

And a big part of the Cardinals' future, if Keim can help it.

Adding to the shine on veteran signal callers is the notion this year's college class doesn't stack up to past years.

"It's going to be fascinating to see who kind of blinks when it comes to these quarterbacks. I don't have one with a top-10 grade," said NFL Network analyst Daniel Jeremiah.

Without a premier prospect among the top QBs — the group that Pitt's Kenny Pickett, Matt Corral of Mississippi, Liberty's Malik Willis and North Carolina's Sam Howell — the first one might not go until the teens because teams will be leery of bypassing a player with a much higher draft grade.

Rainbows and Gold

Even though we haven't seen rain for some time (freezing rain doesn't really count), we have been seeing plenty of rainbows.

Sun dogs look like rainbows, anyway.

Although the multi-colored arch has been used in multiple ways throughout the years, it started out as a promise to never again flood the entire Earth. Today, if you see a cartoon of a rainbow, there is most likely a bearded cartoon man dressed in green accompanying it and we all know what can be found at the end of a rainbow when leprechauns are involved.

A pot of gold, of course.

Now, that's pretty cut-and-dried, right? Gold is gold...except when it's corn.

Let's dig into that a little more.

Corn is a golden color when it's dried properly, but a potful of corn wouldn't be worth as much as the same pot full of gold. If that pot full of corn could hold a bushel (or eight gallons), then it would be worth around six and a half dollars.

The same size pot full of gold would be worth roughly \$30,000.

That's a no-brainer. The gold is worth more every time, right?

But there are exceptions to every rule.

The proverbial pot full of corn is in reality a Pueblo pinch pot made between 900 and 1200 A.D. And it was full of

corn, although the ten-inch-tall pot could only hold about five pounds of corn instead of the bushel that our example discussed. That's less than a tenth of a bushel, so if it were the everyday variety of corn, it would be worth less than a dollar.

But it isn't everyday corn.

A rancher from Mancos, Colorado was moving his cows across a creek and noticed something worth pausing for: A sheltered overhang in a canyon. His cows had previously investigated it and had spent some time in that space, as cows do during weather events and wind.

The rancher, stepping into the alcove, saw a pot near the back wall; likely the first time since its owner had placed it there that the pot came under human eyes.

That happened sometime between the 1960s

and 70s. The rancher scooped up the pot and brought it home, where it sat on a shelf as a decoration for many years.

More recently, artifact collector and fellow Southwestern rancher Steve Campbell purchased the pot from the family. It wasn't until then that the contents of the pot came to light. The pot had a small opening at the bottom, and through it, Campbell was able to get to the inside, which contained corn.

Not too exciting, because corn is a pretty commonplace grain in our area. (Corn is actually a grass, which is why it can be considered a grain).

But this corn is different than all the other corn we're familiar with. It was sealed inside its pot since the pot's creator placed it there - and we know the

pot was made between AD 900 and 1200, according to current dating methods.

The reason why this really old corn is possibly more valuable than gold is for what it can do for modern agriculture. Production of the variety is most likely not as high as today's corn varieties, so it isn't to improve yields. Science wants this corn for its lessened reliance on fertilizer, which they hope to establish in modern corn varieties. This will allow farmers to use less fertilizers in the production of a bumper crop.

Now it's easy to see why this five-pound 'pot of gold' is worth a lot more than many bushels of corn.

Have you ever found an artifact, like an arrowhead? What sort of treasures come home with you after fencing a pasture, or checking cows?
