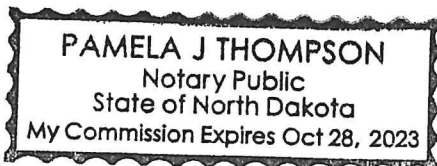

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 3, 2021

On October 21, 2021, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an application for a waiver pursuant to the terms of North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-28 (3), Meter records. The waiver would suspend the existing meter testing plan and associated annual reports for the years 2022 through 2025, to resume in 2026.

The issue to be considered in this matter is whether it is appropriate to grant a waiver of the Commission's rules under North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-28(3), Meter records.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by December 3, 2021.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.


