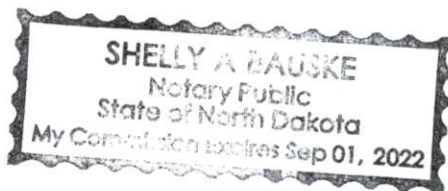

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NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

December 15, 2021

On December 1, 2021, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an application for revisions to its Energy Adjustment Rider tariff to include recovery of an alternate or proxy price for the energy to be generated from the Hoot Lake Solar facility. The tariff revisions would not cause an increase or decrease to North Dakota customers.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether the proposed tariff changes are reasonable, and
2. Whether the tariff changes should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by January 31, 2022.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
