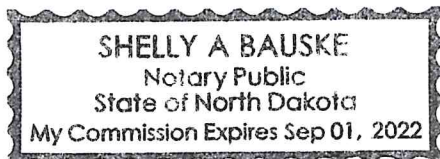


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

June 8, 2022

On June 1, 2022, Great Plains Natural Gas Co. filed an application for a variance to its cost of gas true-up pursuant to the terms of North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-39, Automatic Adjustment Clauses. The variance would eliminate the true-up surcharge effective July 1, 2022. The current surcharge is set at \$1.9667 per dekatherm and is set to expire on September 30, 2022.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether it is appropriate to grant a waiver of the Commission's rules under North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-39, Automatic Adjustment Clauses, for the stated purpose.
2. Whether the proposed rate change is just and reasonable.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by July 15, 2022.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
