Revision to application for Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Adjustment Factor
Otter Tail Power Company

On December 29, 2021, we filed a request with the North Dakota Public Service Commission to decrease our Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Rider Factor, which is the Renewable Rider line on your bill. The Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Rider allows us to recover costs associated with renewable generation resources.

Please see panel below for more information.

The proposed change to the Renewable Resource Cost Recovery Rider Factor is for usage on and after April 1, 2022. The proposed rate for all classes of service is 7.108% of base charges and credits. The current rate is 11.825%. This proposed update would decrease the charge on base rates by 3.040%, or approximately \$3.23 on an average residential customer's bill. This change is proposed only and, if suspended by the Commission, will not be effective until the Commission takes action.
