

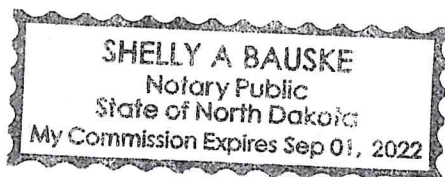

February 23, 2022

A Public Hearing on the applications in Case No. PU-22-34 is scheduled to begin April 5, 2022 at 9:00 AM CT, at the Mandan City Hall, Ed “Bosh” Froehlich Meeting Room, 205 Second Avenue Northwest, Mandan, ND 58554.

On January 18, 2022, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. filed a combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit concerning the location of approximately 2684 feet of 12-inch water pipeline in Morton County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The issues in the application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permits are:


1. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facilities at the proposed locations produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?

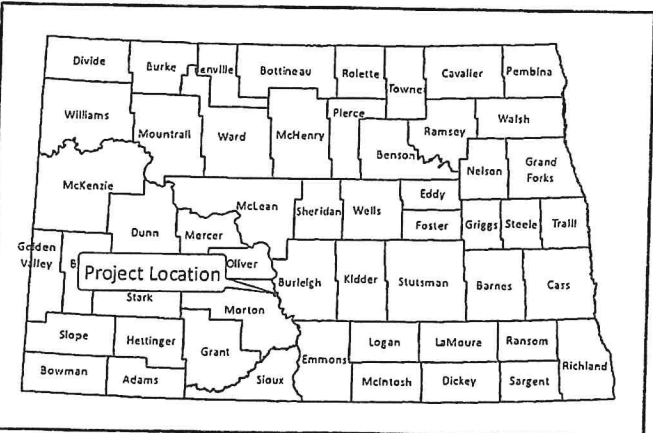
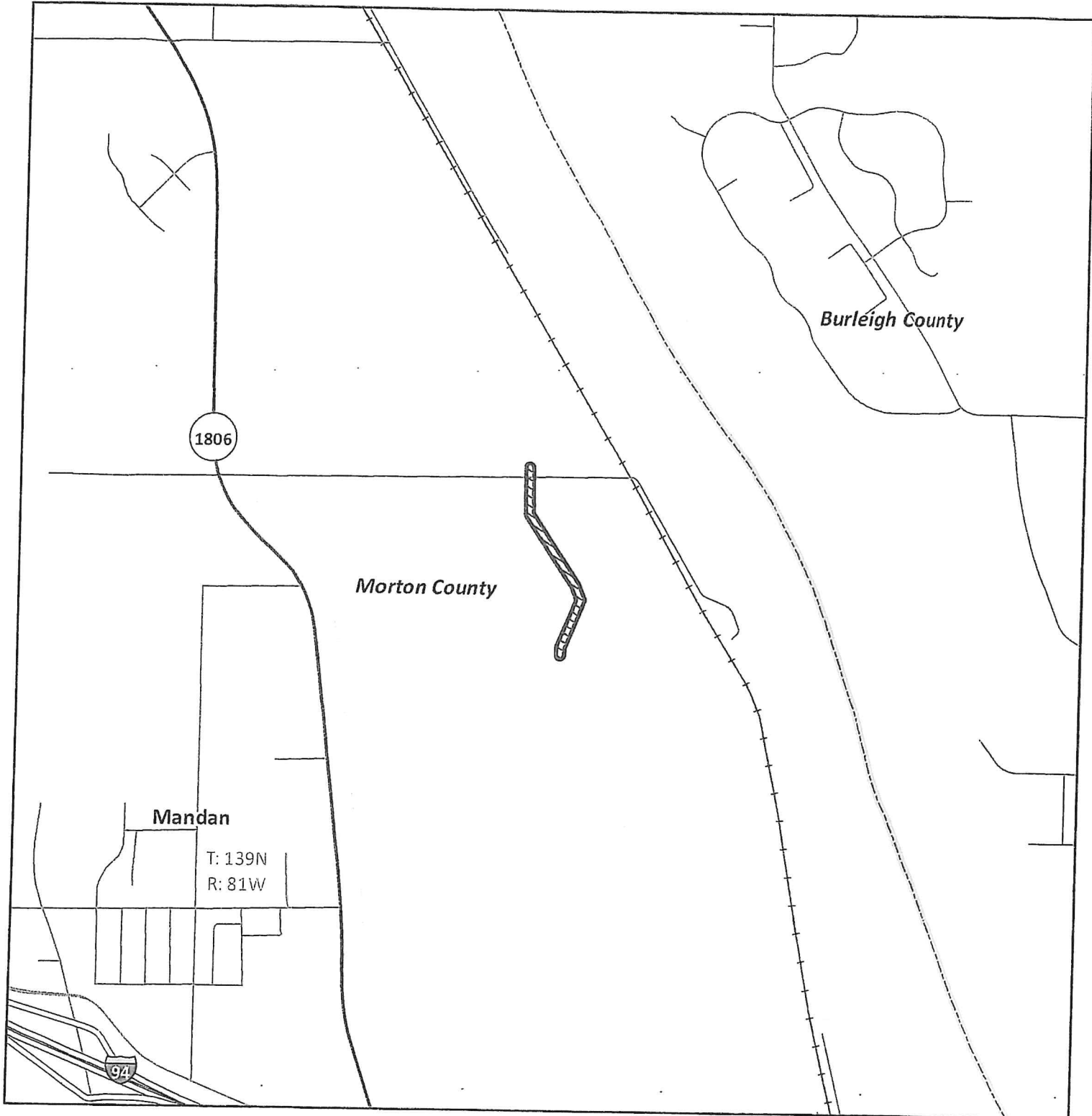

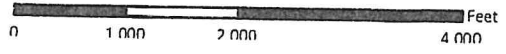
