

MDU Heskett Station Water Line – Monthly Construction Project Report

Project Overview – The MDU Heskett Station water line is a new construction waterline that will tie into the City of Mandan water main to supply fire protection and service water to the Heskett Combustion Turbine site.

Monthly Progress – Carstensen Contracting Incorporated (CCI) officially began construction on the project on 14 May 2022 while Keitu Engineers and Consultants were onsite to witness topsoil removal. CCI has stripped topsoil and installed BMPs for the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). Approximately 50% of the pipe has been fused and will be placed in the trench in the future. 38th Street was successfully bored, and casing was installed under the road.

Environmental – BMPs were installed as detailed in the SWPPP. No Environmental concerns to note.

Cultural Impacts – No items to report.

Damage to UG Facilities – An MDU owned waterline was hit while boring 38th Street and was repaired, this only effected the MDU Heskett facility.

Landowner/Public Issues or Complaints – None to report.

Permitting – Highway permits for transporting materials were filed in North Dakota and South Dakota. A Road crossing permit was filed for Morton County.
