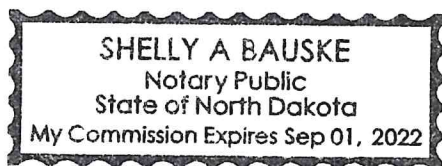

STAFF RESPONSE TO APPLICATION FOR PROTECTION OF INFORMATION

On June 10, 2022, Badger Wind, LLC. (Badger) filed an Application for Protection of Information to protect certain information in the captioned case.

The information for which the Company seeks protection includes cultural resource location information contained in Figures 2 and 2.1 through 2.7, and the figure at the end of Appendix B of the Class III Cultural Resources Inventory, along with associated GIS data.

North Dakota Century Code (N.D.C.C.) 49-22-26 allows the commission to limit access to, and release of, information that contains data that specifically identifies the location of cultural, archaeological, historical, or paleontological sites.

Staff believes that Badger's application satisfies the requirements of the North Dakota Century Code for protection of the information, which is the subject of this request.

For reasons set forth above, Staff recommends that the Commission grant the application of Badger to protect certain information filed in the captioned case.
