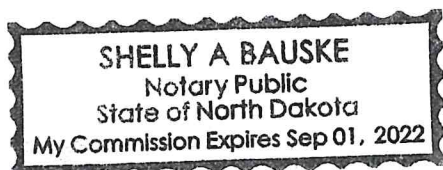


NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING

May 4, 2022

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-22-141 is scheduled to begin **June 6, 2022, at 9:00 A.M. CT, at Williston City Hall, John Kautzman Chamber Room, 22 East Broadway, Williston, ND 58801.**

On March 3, 2022, Continental Resources, Inc. (Continental) filed a combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit concerning the location of approximately 3.1 miles of 8-inch natural gas pipeline in Williams County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The pipeline will transport natural gas from an existing transmission pipeline to an existing oil well for an enhanced oil recovery pilot program.

Continental also filed an application for waiver of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22.1-05, 49-22.1-06, 49-22.1-07, 49-22.1-08, and 49-22.1-10, and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02 and chapter 69-06-06, requiring separate notices and separate hearings on such applications. Continental also requested a waiver of the proposed corridor width required under North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-05-01(2)(f).

The issues in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:

1. Is the proposed facility of such length, design, location, or purpose that it will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues in the application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit are:

1. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility at the proposed location produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility at the proposed location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

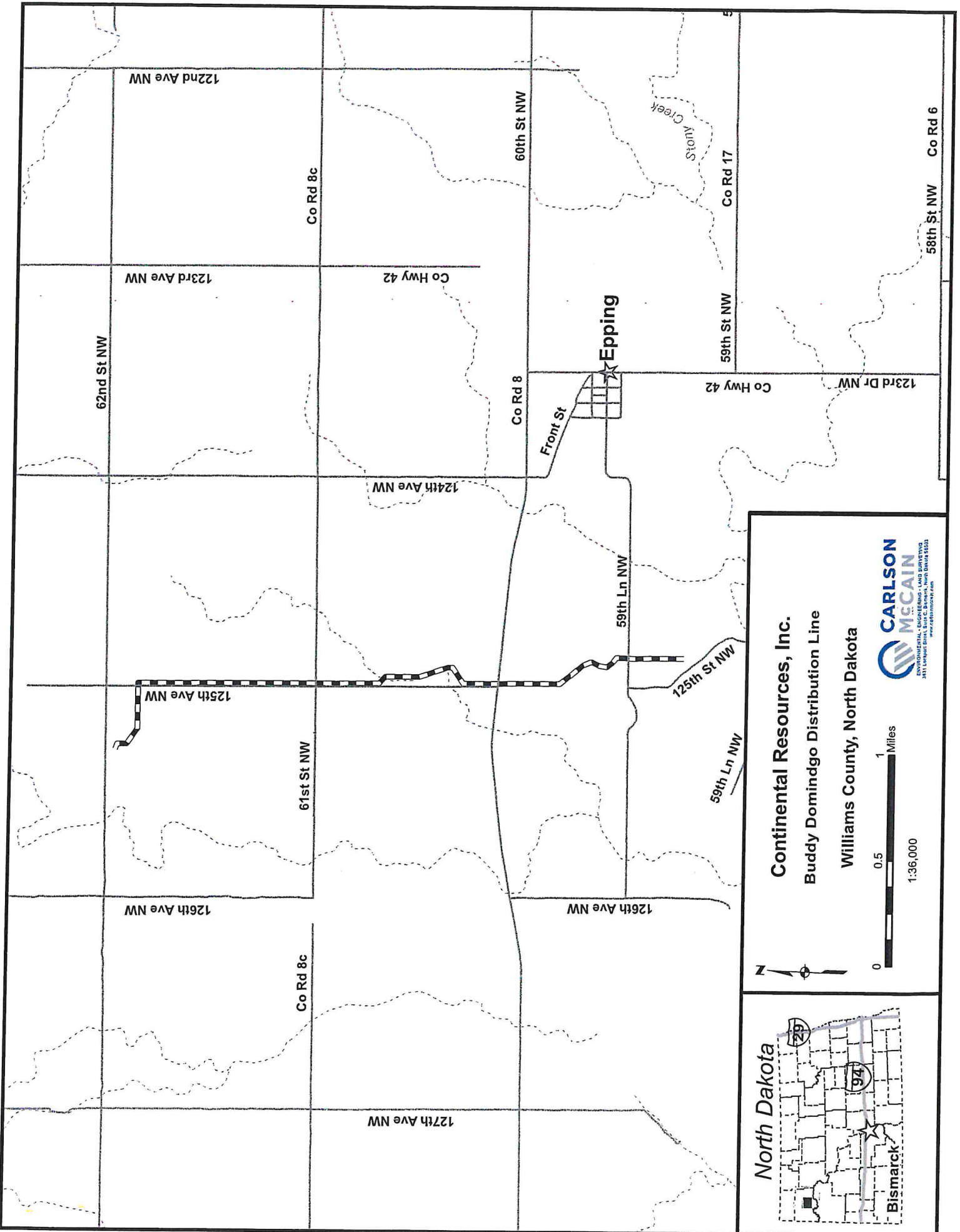
