Minutes

Meeting started at 3:02 PM via Teams

Adam asked for somebody to take meeting minutes. Jared Weingartner volunteered.

Introductions were given, and then Adam explained the basis for the meeting.

Adam asked who will be responsible for landowner complaints. Jennifer Hill is the designated CLR representative for landowner complaints, and her phone number is 405-774-5778.

Adam directed that all emails to the PSC should be addressed to ndpsc@nd.gov. The phone number is 877-245-6685. He then confirmed all attendees had the Findings of Fact Conclusions of Law and Order (Findings) and started to go through the items. Adam called specific attention to items 8, 21, 27, 30, and 31 of the Findings.

Adam then called to attention the requirements of Order dictating that the route construction buffer of 20 feet on each side of the designated route. He emphasized that spills require notification within 24 hours by leaving a message at the previously mentioned PSC number as well as an email to the PSC secretary at smkahl@nd.gov.

Adam turned over meeting to Jamie. Jamie called out the requirements that the inspector is required to be on site to witness the topsoil movement. Keitu will need to be onsite. Cory indicted they plan to start topsoil around 7/29 but will confirm with Jamie via phone and email. Continental will begin preliminary construction activities on 7/25 and must notify the Commission of this date by email with the case number in an email to ndpsc@nd.gov. These minutes will serve as that notification.

Actual topsoil stripping dates will be coordinated with Jamie via phone and email.

Adam reiterated that Continental is required to send a monthly status update to the commission.

Jamie called out item 11 (depth of cover) and item 12 around topsoil segregation requirements not limited to but including segregation areas and storage requirements. Adam then touched on items 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 28, 30, 33, 34, and 37-40.

Adam noted that OSHA recordable incidents should be reported to the PSC. Jamie went over the expected construction inspection intervals:

1. Top soil inspection
2. Construction inspection
3. As-built inspection
4. Reclamation inspection

After the Findings were completely reviewed the meeting was called to a conclusion.

Meeting ended at 3:38pm CDT.
